

BPI Accounting Upgrade Path

Sage Software has announced that BPI Accounting will no longer be supported starting in 2008. Both tax table and telephone support will be discontinued. What are BPI users to do?

BPI users interested in preserving all their transaction data will want to investigate **21st Century Accounting**. It is the only upgrade path that converts all the accounts, balances, and transactions in your BPI company. The data conversion is a one-click process and does not alter your original BPI company.

Since 21st Century Accounting was developed by some of the original BPI programmers, it looks and feels more similar to BPI than any other accounting software does. In fact, the software's online help has a "BPI map" that can be consulted to see exactly how BPI functions correspond to the new software.

Because of these connections between BPI and 21st Century Accounting, the learning curve for BPI users should be much lower.
